The Interdisciplinary Digital Studio (IDS) program in Penn State's School of Visual Arts offers a bachelor of design (B.Des.) degree.

The program was created to meet the technical, creative, and intellectual needs of students who want to pursue careers in digital art and design. The curriculum incorporates learning experiences that enable students to further their technological literacy by learning and working in environments that foster interdisciplinary communication and collaboration.

Admission IDS is a highly selective professional degree program. Admission is based on a review of (1) the University application for admission with complete academic credentials, (2) a portfolio of art and design works in the form of a compact disc, videotape, or Web site, and (3) a written statement.
